Could a 400-megawatt battery energy storage system be built in Abu Dhabi?

State-owned Emirates Water and Electricity Company has requested proposals from 27 qualified companies and consortiums to develop a greenfield 400-megawatt battery energy storage system project in Abu Dhabi. The request for proposals is being issued to bidders who passed the qualification process following the expression of interest in April 2024.

Could a greenfield 400 MW battery energy storage system be developed in Abu Dhabi?

The UAE's Emirates Water and Electricity Company (EWEC) has issued a request for proposals (RFP) to qualified developers and developer consortiums that expressed interest in developing a greenfield 400 MW battery energy storage system (BESS) in Abu Dhabi.

Why is EWEC deploying Bess in Abu Dhabi?

“Ewec is deploying bess to enhance the flexibility and stability of Abu Dhabi's energy network, allowing for the effective management of peak demand and integration of increasing amounts of renewable energy,” the utility said in a media statement on 25 July.

Where will a new plant be located in Abu Dhabi?

The first plant will be in Al-Bihouth, approximately 45 kilometres (km) southwest of Abu Dhabi, and the second plant will be in Madinat Zayed, about 160km southwest of the city.
