

What is China's energy storage capacity?

China has total energy storage capacity of about 35 GW as of 2020, of which only 3.3 GW was new energy storage, according to the China Energy Storage Alliance.

How big is China's power storage industry?

Industry estimates show that China's power storage industry will have up to 100 million kilowatts of installed capacity by 2025, and 420 million kW installed capacity by 2060, attracting related investment of over 1.6 trillion yuan, said Li Jie, general manager of power storage at State Grid Integrated Energy Service Group Co Ltd.

Why is energy storage important in China?

Experts said developing energy storage is an important step in China's transition from fossil fuels to a renewable energy mix, while mitigating the impact of new energy's randomness, volatility, intermittence on the grid and managing power supply and demand.

Will energy storage support solar and wind plants in China?

At least 10 regions in China have ordered renewable power developers to install energy storage as supporting facilities of the solar and wind plants.

How much energy storage does China have in 2023?

By the end of 2023, China had completed and put into operation a cumulative installed capacity of new type energy storage projects reaching 31.4GW/66.9GWh, with an average storage duration of 2.1 hours. The newly added installed capacity in 2023 was approximately 22.6GW /48.7GWh, which is three times that for 2022 (7.3GW /15.9GWh).

Are lithium-ion batteries a good storage option?

In terms of storage types, the dominant advantage of lithium-ion batteries continues to expand, accounting for 97.4% of the new type storage installation. Other types, such as air compression, and redox flow cell, have also achieved some breakthroughs, but their proportions remain low.
