How do gravity batteries store gravitational potential energy?

What is a gravity battery?

A gravity battery is a type of energy storage device that stores gravitational energy--the potential energy E given to an object with a mass m when it is raised against the force of gravity of Earth ($g, 9.8 \text{ m/s}^2$) into a height difference h .

How do gravity batteries work?

The clock was powered by the force of gravity using an escapement mechanism, that made a pendulum move back and forth. Since then, gravity batteries have advanced into systems that can utilize the force due to gravity, and turn it into electricity for large scale energy storage.

Why is gravitational potential energy important?
